- Sunday 10th March 2019
 - Check into Atlantis Marcoola where we have 3 nights' accommodation with 5 people sharing each 3 bedroom x 2 bathroom apartment.
- Wednesday 13th March 2019
 - Check out of Atlantis (10:00 am) for flights home.
- 2 rounds of golf at Twin Waters and Maroochy River including motorised carts and reserved tee times.
 - Monday 11th March – Pick up at 10:45 am and transfer to Twin waters where we have a Midday shot gun start.
 - Tuesday 12th March – Pick up 10:45 am and transfer to Maroochy River where we have a midday shot gun start.
 - Lunch will be provided each day in the form of a gourmet sandwich, chocolate bar, piece of fruit, slice of cake and a bottle of water or sports drink.
- Sunday arrival dinner at Surf Air – Premium Australian Buffett (including a 3 hour drinks package of white and red wine, beer, soft drinks.).
- Delegates meeting at 5pm in the boardroom at Surf Air.
- Dinner at Maroochy River after the round of golf on Tuesday. (2 course set menu and also a 2 hour drinks package including white and red wine, beer and soft drinks.)

The accommodation is at:

Atlantis Marcoola. Located in Marcoola, this fantastic resort is located a very short drive from the Sunshine Coast Airport and a short trip to both golf courses selected – Twin Waters and Maroochy River.

The apartments at Atlantis are all roomy and comfortable and are a leisurely walk to the Surf Air Bar and a choice of cafes for breakfast or a coffee fix.

Not only are the apartments very comfortable but the resort has the best heated outdoor pool you will find on the Sunshine Coast and it also has a gym and the amazing Marcoola Beach is right on your back doorstep.

Twin Waters Golf Club

Twin Waters Golf Course is internationally recognised as one of the top six resort courses in Australia – in many people's opinion it is the best on the Sunshine Coast. The 18 hole, par 72 championship course was designed by five times British Open champion Peter Thomson and partner Mike Wolveridge. The stunning setting and challenging layout combine to produce an enjoyable game of golf for all players.

The practice facilities are excellent with a large putting green, a separate chipping green, a large practice bunker and a driving range in the form of a large lake.

The course offers generous fairways with large undulating greens and is a fair test of golf for all levels of golfers. The course has many resident kangaroos and an abundance of bird life.

One of the unique features of the course is the close proximity of the Sunshine Coast Airport which means there are many occasions during the day where you can almost count the number of passengers on board.

Maroochy River Golf Club

Designed by Graham Marsh, the 18-hole par 72 layout is unique in that it is basically a links-style course, with wide fairways, few trees and lots of strategically placed bunkers. What makes it challenging is the water, which is a feature of almost every hole, and the wind. It's a rare day that the wind does not affect play, but one important benefit is that it keeps golfers cool in even the warmest weather.

With the iconic Mt Coolum as a spectacular background, Maroochy River is an all-purpose golf complex, offering superb practice facilities, a well-stocked pro shop, a modern clubhouse with outstanding bar and bistro facilities, a function room capable of hosting weddings, conferences and dinners, and – most importantly – friendly staff who make every visitor feel welcome.
